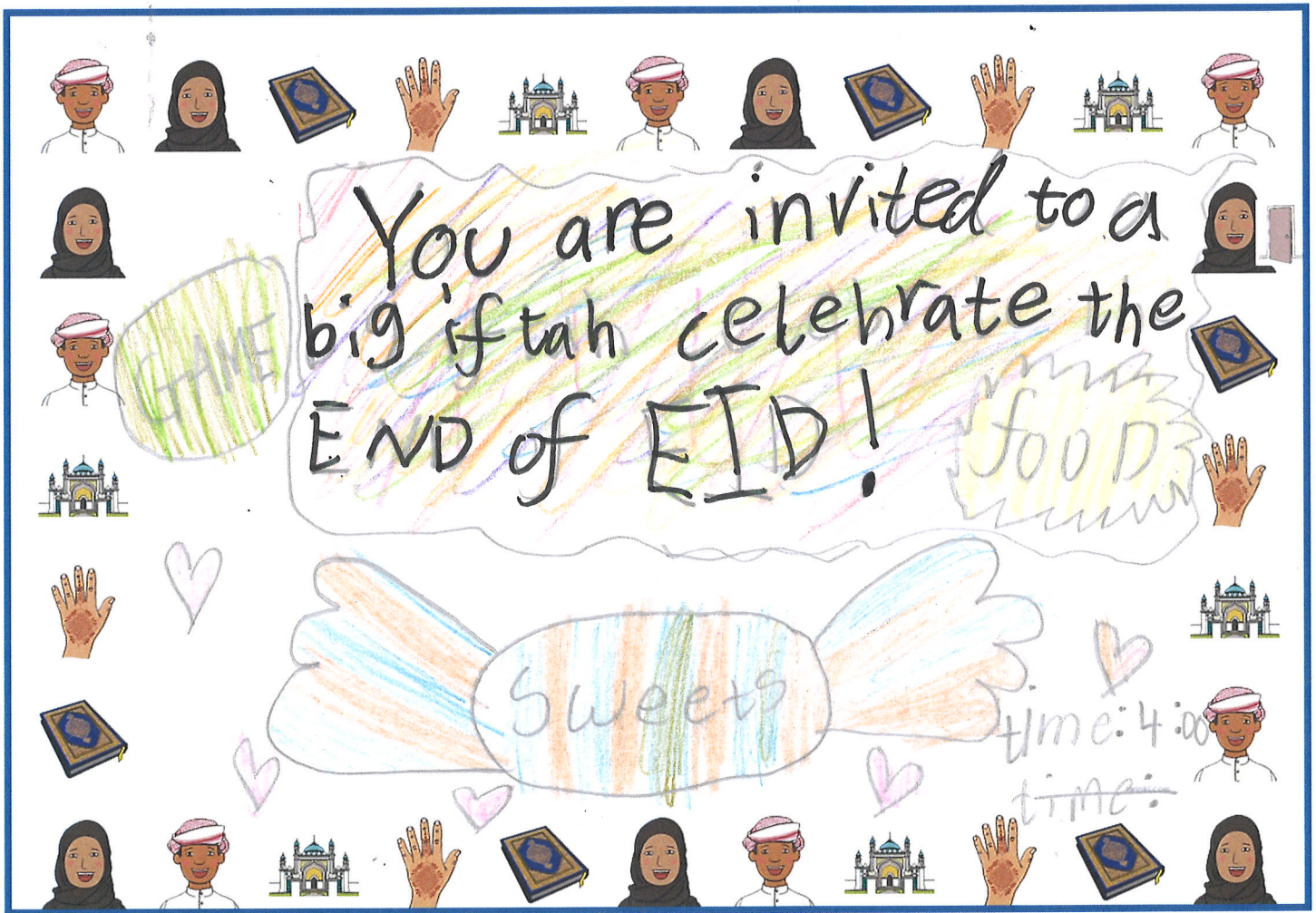




RE: Why is Eid important to Muslims?
