Dear Parents

We have organised our annual theatre visit as so many parents and children feel it is a valuable experience.

We have booked tickets to take the Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children to see The Tiger Who Came to Tea at Birmingham Town Hall. Reception and Year 1 will go on the afternoon of Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> January and Year 2 will go on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2019. The performance starts at 1.00pm therefore we shall leave school after an early lunch and return to school at approximately 2.45pm. The cost of this visit is £14 per child. The cost is broken down as follows:

- £10.90 – ticket cost
- £3.25 - coach cost
- 10p - insurance cost
- -25p -school subsidy

We would like to remind parents that payments of any size can be made throughout the Autumn term.

This event is an experience that is enjoyed by all who attend. The specific aims of the visit are:

- To experience a live theatre performance
- To support the children’s language development

The theatre performance is also followed up with cross-curricular work at school.

The 1988 Education Act and Governors’ Policy require me to make it clear that our intended visit can only take place if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and no child will be omitted from taking part, **but it will be necessary to have substantial parental contributions for the visit to go ahead.** Please do not hesitate to contact school if you have any queries.
