Attendance

This is an area of national concern with declining attendance at both primary and secondary level. The figures here are above local and national averages but much lower compared to what we have seen in the past.

Overall attendance: 95.2% (National: 94.1%) The breakdown for each year group is as follows:

 Reception: 91.9%
 Year 1: 94.7%
 Year 2: 96.1%

 Year 3: 95.1%
 Year 4: 95.5%
 Year 5: 96.1%

Year 6: 96.2%

Leave in term time is only authorised in exceptional circumstances and only after a written request has been made and agreed by the school in advance. A list of term dates for the next two academic years is on the next page. These are intended to give plenty of notice so holidays can be taken outside term time.

New government regulations for attendance will be in force from September. These are tougher than those currently in place so there will be a continued focus on this area.
